Member Father Mike Hanly retires as Pastor of "Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church Verona" Beloved Pastor from 1994-2014

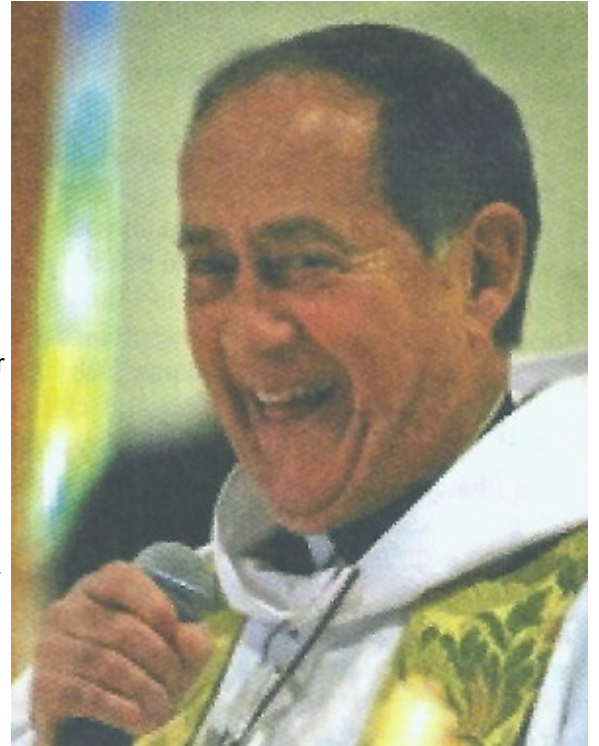

Over the past several years Father Mike has made multiple monthly visits to our Wounded Warriors & their families at Walter Reed National Military Hospital, Bethesda, MD.

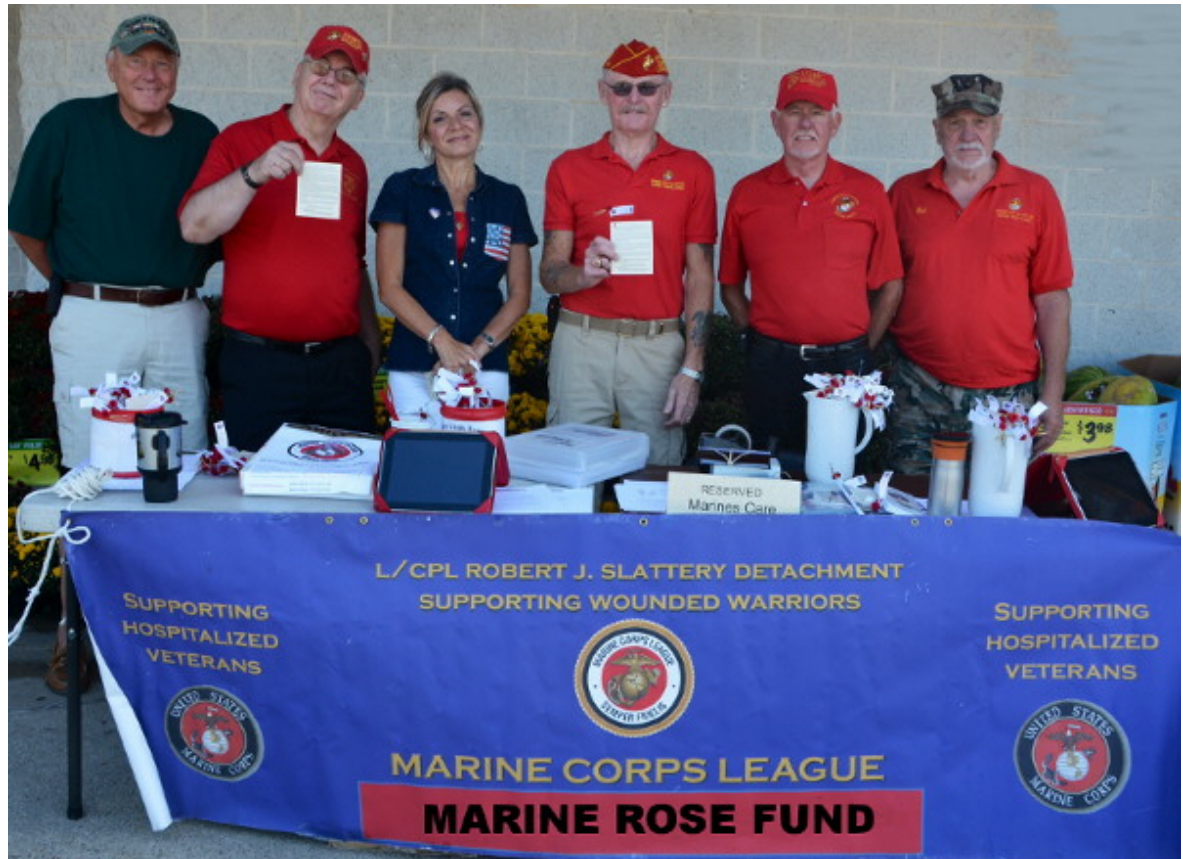

**BEWARE OF PHONE SCAMS**

September 9, 2014: A Police officer saves man from phone scam as reported in the Daily Record. the officer was familiar with the recent trend in scams where victims received a phone call with the caller claiming to be from the IRS or utility company and demanding the victim make an immediate payment via MoneyPak or face charges or loss of services. Victims have been reported earlier this year in Long Hill, Hanover, Randolph, Madison and Hopatcong. The Police advise the public to be alert & wary of suspicious calls.

JCP&L reports: If a customer receives a call from someone demanding payment of their electric bill by using a Green Dot card they are being scammed and should report it immediately to local authorities. JCP&L does not endorse the use of Green Dot cards as a bill payment method..
