Lance Corporal Robert J. Slattery Detachment #206 Marine Corps League

Section III, Military Order of Devil Dog Fleas

The Lance Corporal Robert J. Slattery Detachment, Marine Corps League recognizes the Military Order of the Devil Dog Fleas as an official subsidiary organization of the Marine Corps League, Marine Corps League Auxiliary, which shall ever be subject to the authority, supervision, direction, control and discipline of the Marine Corps League. Membership in the Order shall be limited to members of the Marine Corps League Auxiliary. (Article 7, Section 7001 National Bylaws applies.)

Section IV, Subsidiaries Young Marines of the Marine Corps League

The Lance Corporal Robert J. Slattery Detachment Marine Corps League recognizes the Young Marines of the Marine Corps League as an official subsidiary organization of the Marine Corps League which shall ever be subject to the authority, supervision, direction, control and discipline of the Marine Corps League. (Article 7, Section 700r National By-laws applies.)

CHAPTER 5 – Grievance and Discipline

All matters pertaining to the resolving of grievances and/or discipline against any member, Detachment or Department shall be processed in accordance with Section 900, 901, 902, 903, 900, 905 and 909, 910, 912 and 913 of Chapter Nine, National Administrative Procedures.

CHAPTER 6 – Marine of the Year

Section I – Marine of the Year Award

Committee: A Detachment Marine of the Year Award Committee consisting of the five (5) most recent Detachment Marines of the Year shall serve on the committee only. The most senior of these Detachment Marines of the Year shall, in his last year of eligibility for service on the Committee, serve as Chairperson of the Committee.

Criteria Used in Selecting: The following criteria shall be used in selecting the Detachment Marine of the Year:

- All Detachment members, in good standing, may nominate, in writing, a Detachment member (also in good standing) as that year's nominee for the Detachment Marine of the Year.
- The Marine of the Year Committee shall select a suitable candidate from the written nominations.
- All deliberations of the Committee shall be held in strict confidentiality.
- The Committee shall also cause a suitable plaque to be engraved and presented to the selected at an appropriate ceremony.
