

Administrative Procedures

Lance Corporal Robert J. Slattery Detachment #206, Marine Corps League

- Nominations shall be made at the October and November regular business meetings of the Detachment, with the Detachment Marine of the Year selected being announced at the January holiday social meeting.
- Each year, the selected shall also be nominated, by the Detachment, as the Department Marine of the Year nominee from the Lance Corporal Robert J. Slattery Detachment, Marine Corps League, Inc.
- The nomination for the Department Marine of the Year shall be made in timely fashion, in order that it may be considered by the Department Marine of the Year Committee, at the Department Convention following the June regular business meeting at which the Detachment Marine of the Year is announced.

CHAPTER 7 – Miscellaneous

Section I, Fund Raising

a) **Fund Raising:** Fund raising activities may be entered into by Marine Corps League organization.

- 1) Providing all funds raised shall be for the sole benefit of such organization less such expenses incurred.
- 2) Provided such Marine Corps League organizations shall receive and disburse all funds.
- 3) Provided such funding activity does not violate any Federal, State, County or Municipal law or ordinance or reflect discredit upon the Marine Corps League.
- 4) Nothing in the foregoing section shall prevent the National Convention Committee, or the Department Convention Committee from selling ads or soliciting funds for their annual Convention Book.

b) **Solicitation:** Any individual or committee soliciting funds for the Detachment using the name of the Marine Corps League, whether selling advertising or merchandise of any sort or soliciting donations, must submit a complete, signed, written report to the Detachment upon regular intervals as directed by the Detachment Staff as to the amount and source of all funds disbursed and summary of the final disposition of and all net profits.

Section II, Respect

a) The Bible shall be opened, placed on an altar, which is covered with a clean, and attractive altar cloth, during all the meetings of the Marine Corps League. No disrespect to the Bible, by any act or word, shall be tolerated. No one shall use the Altar for physical support, and shall not, under any circumstances, use the Altar or Bible as a resting place for any item or material. All space between the Altar and the Chair shall be considered as hallowed ground and shall not be traveled upon while the Bible is open. The Ritual of the Marine Corps League shall be observed and employed at all meetings and appropriate functions to the maximum extent possible.
